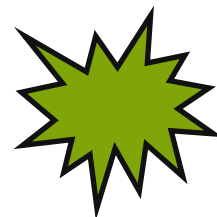

By now great numbers of the 400 mimeographs had been returned (from those we sent who might be concerned with the problems of alcoholism).

Dr. Howard, a psychiatrist from Montclair New Jersey, pointed out that the book was too full of words like, "you" and "must". He suggested that we substitute "we ought" or "we should". His idea was to remove all forms or coercion to place out fellowship on a "we ought" basis instead of "you must". this would be a big job. I argued against this change but soon gave in.

It was apparent that Dr. Silkworth and Dr Tiebout gave us similar advice. And we must never forget that is was Dr Silkworth, who wrote the introduction to the first edition of Alcoholics Anonymous.
