We were still arguing about the 12 steps right before the manuscript was finished.

I would not change a word of the original draft in which, I had consistently used the word "God" and in one place the expression " On our knees" was used. though at first I would have none of it, we finally came to an agreement to compromise.

In Step 2 we decided to describe God as "a Power greater than ourselves"

In Steps 3 and 11 we inserted the words "God as we understood him"

From step 7 we deleted the expression " On our knees" and as a lead in to the steps we wrote these words:

"Here are the Steps we took which are suggested as a Program of Recovery"

The Step are suggestions only.

Such were the concessions to those of little or no faith: this was the great contribution of our Atheists and Agnostics.

God was there in our steps but was He was now expressed in terms that anybody—Anybody at all—could accept and try.
