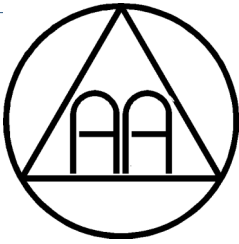

Archives Corner



The original Big Book is now in the GSO Archives in New York. The first AA Big Book ever sold, April 1939, was bought by Virginia MacLeod at a meeting in Bill W's apartment, Clinton Street, New York.

Bill Wilson writes: The title "Alcoholics Anonymous" had appeared early in the discussion [of the Big Book] probably October of 1938. After we New Yorkers left the Oxford Groups in 1937 we often described ourselves as a "nameless bunch of alcoholics" From this phrase it was only a step to the idea of Alcoholics Anonymous..

But as the naming [of the Big Book] discussion went on I began to have doubts and temptations. From the start "The Way Out" was popular [among alcoholics]. If we gave the book this name then I could add my signature: "By Bill W".

After all why shouldn't an author sign his book?. I began to forget this was everybody's book and that I was mostly the umpire of the discussion. I whispered these ideas to a few friends and got slapped down.

Then I saw the temptation for what it was a shameless piece of egotism. So once more I voted for "Alcoholics Anonymous".
